STORY OF CEREMONY:

First produced as a non-vintage (2011, 13,14) traditional method estate grown sparkler, Ceremony, named with a nod to New Order, has been one of our most popular releases, demonstrating the ongoing success of sparkling wines grown in Prince Edward County.

GROWING SEASON:

The 2019 growing season was cool with a later than usual start resulting in long hang time for flavour development.

HARVEST:

Harvest proceeded under dry conditions with a bountiful crop of clean distinctive chardonnay.

WINEMAKING:

The fruit was chilled and cluster-pressed with a fraction held back and fermented separately. Fermentation took place in neutral and second-fill French oak followed by a seven-month's elevage in our cellar prior to bottling.
