About this wine: The grapes for this small batch wine come from a single vineyard in the south of Creek Shores sub-appellation, where rich sedimentary soils bring great depth to the fruit. The long growing season and extended hang-time of the 2019 vintage provided further complexity, and the result is a structured wine of nuance and balance.

Sub Appellation: Creek Shores VQA

Vineyard: Single Vineyard - planted in late 90's (Creek Shores)

Soil: Clay

Grapes: 100% Cabernet Franc

Vinification: Wild fermented and aged in French oak barrels for 16 months. 25% new French barrels
