



Wine: Black Bank Hill 2020 Pinot Noir, Twenty Mile Bench VQA

Price per bottle: \$35.00 retail, \$27.72 licensee

<u>Varietals, Vineyard & Harvest</u>: 100% Pinot Noir from the Twenty Mile Bench. A blend of 3-barrels from Glen Elgin vineyard and 1-barrel from the End-of-the-Road vineyard.

Winemaking: Destemmed and lightly crushed, a wild ferment and 18-months élevage in neutral French oak and blended in the Spring prior to bottling. Lightly filtered prior to bottling 4 July 2022.

Wine Description: Medium violet in colour. A lovely, perfumed Pinot Noir from the Twenty Mile Bench, striking a balance between the richer characteristics of the 2020 vintage and the typically fresh and elegant nature of our cool climate region. Cherry, strawberry, red liquorice, rose, earl grey tea, mushrooms, loam. Medium-bodied with balanced acidity and silky texture due to the ripe and fine tannins of the vintage.

Sweetness: Fully dry, 2.0 g/L residual sugar

Alcohol by Volume: 12.9%
