ABOUT THIS WINE

Made with Gamay from the Creek Road Vineyard, this rosé all about bringing together expression of site, grape variety, and technique.

Hand harvested grapes, whole cluster pressing, saignée, and blending in a splash of Sauvignon Blanc (from the same site!) make this a stylish and fresh rosé.

The different components were blended and allowed to integrate for a few months before bottling. Crisp, fruity, textured, and complex, the wine is perfect for any occasion.

SENSORY PROFILE

Pale salmon colour with aromas of fresh strawberry, cherry, and tropical fruit salad. On the palate the wine is bright and lively with refreshing acidity, adding watermelon rind and citrus. Substantial volume and weight carry the wine leading to a long and textured finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Enjoy on a warm afternoon or use it to remind you of summertime in your glass during the cooler months. This wine will accompany a variety of foods from charcuterie to grilled seafood and fresh salads.

CELLARING POTENTIAL

Rosé is great when fresh but also have great aging potential due to their acid and tannin structure. Drink from release until at least 2026.
