Tasting Notes:

Expressive mid-weight traditional method sparkling rose of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir with the most beautiful apricot hue. The approachable dry palate has a texturally appealing fine elegant mousse. Exotic notes of dried orange peel, marmalade, creme fraiche and apricot play nicely with toasted almond brioche speaking to its 48 months on lees. Lafontaine has a saline minerality typical of the region, a lively acidity and persistent lengthy finish
