THE APPELLATION:
VQA LINCOLN LAKESHORE

THE HARVEST:
October 16, 2020

THE VARIETAL PROFILE:
100% Syrah

THE NOTES:

The 38-acre property is named for its heavy red clay soil and large stones, and is perfect for maturing late-ripening varieties like Syrah. This structured wine was aged 16 months in French oak, and displays notes of red raspberry, cranberry and black currant. On the palate there are notes of ripe fruits with dried herbs, coffee and cocoa powder. Strong tannins are present which will soften as the wine ages.

THE PAIRINGS:

This Syrah will pair with all kinds of grilled meats, such as beef, lamb or venison. With the Rhone style to this wine try it with a lamb cassoulet, or duck confit.
